Yiwu International Trade City - districts, floors and what each one actually sells

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District 1 opened Oct 2002 340,000 m² 10,000+ booths

1F artificial flowers, toys
2F hair ornaments, jewelry
3F festival & decorative crafts, photo frames, jewelry parts
4F factory outlet centre

Go here if you buy: Toys, fashion jewelry, seasonal decor

District 2 opened Oct 2004 600,000+ m² 8,000+ booths

1F bags, luggage, umbrellas, rainwear
2F hardware tools, electrical, locks
3F kitchenware, small appliances, telecom, clocks & watches
4F outlet & specialty halls 5F foreign-trade service centre

Go here if you buy: Hardware, electronics, bags

District 3 opened 2005 460,000 m² 6,000+ standard + 600+ large

1F pens & ink, paper, eyewear
2F office supplies, sports goods
3F cosmetics, mirrors & combs, zippers, buttons, garment accessories
4-5F large showrooms (80-100 m²)

Go here if you buy: Stationery, cosmetics, garment trims

District 4 opened Oct 2008 1,080,000 m² 16,000+ booths

1F socks
2F daily consumables, hats, gloves
3F towels, wool yarn, ties, lace, sewing thread
4F scarves, belts, underwear

Go here if you buy: Hosiery, textiles, soft goods - largest single district

District 5 opened 2011 640,000 m² 7,000+ booths

1F imported goods, African products, foods
2F bedding
3F towels, knitting materials, fabrics, curtains
4F automotive & motorcycle accessories

Go here if you buy: Home textiles, auto accessories, imports

District 6 opened 14 Oct 2025 410,000 m² hall 3,700 merchants at opening

Global Digital Trade Center - 8 new-industry zones
Fashion jewelry, trendy toys, smart equipment
Showroom downstairs, contract offices upstairs
Site total 1.25 million m²

Go here if you buy: Own-brand / IP products, smart hardware

Getting Around Yiwu

Satellite markets, shuttle lines and the things that cost first-time buyers a day

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Markets outside Districts 1-6

Huangyuan Market

Professional clothing & apparel

- 1F jeans & trousers
- 2F men's wear
- 3F women's wear
- 4F pyjamas & sportswear

Production Materials Market

Inputs for factories

- 1F plastics, particles, raw inputs
- 2F printing, injection moulding, packaging machinery
- 3F commercial lighting & synthetic leather

Free market shuttle lines

- Line 2 Passenger Centre <-> Materials Market
- Line 3 Railway Station <-> Nanfang Lian
- Line 5 Yiwu Airport <-> Nanfang Lian

Before you go

The market runs about 7 km end to end. Pick a district and a floor before you arrive - walking it without a plan is the single most common way first-time buyers lose a day.

Districts 1-5 are connected; District 6 (Global Digital Trade Center) is a separate site. Huangyuan and the Production Materials Market are also off-site - budget travel time.

Booth numbers run in a grid. Write down district + floor + gate + booth number, in that order, or you will not find the same stall twice.

Most booths are trading companies, not factories. Ask to see the workshop before you assume the person quoting you is the one manufacturing.
